Player Responsibilities

The enjoyment of golf depends largely on the courtesy and consideration extended to fellow golfers both on the green and the clubhouse. Bad language or unruly behaviour will not be tolerated.

Player responsibility includes knowing the rules of golf and the conditions of play for the event being played.

Social players must pay before tee off and carry a receipt or be asked to leave the course.

Sand buckets are to be carried at all times.

Players are to repair divots and plug marks on the greens.

Players must observe the club dress code. Sun Smart clothing is essential with appropriate shoes and socks. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry for inappropriate clothing. Casual footwear is permitted around the clubhouse (except on formal occasions).

COMPETITION PLAYER NOTES

All questions on rules should be referred to the Captain.

The person marking your card is the only person responsible for giving you a ruling on how to proceed. They may seek advice from other players in the group.

Slow play will not be tolerated. Any group taking more than 4.5 hours to complete a round may be penalised 2 strokes at the discretion of the Captain.

It is the responsibility of all players to check their handicap before they hit off.

All players should be aware of local rules applicable to the day's play.
